
The major difference between Taj and Classic is that Taj has an additional pearlized topcoat, resulting in a higher sheen. The pearl effect is is applied to the hides by machine; it does not flake off over time as the application is permanent and there is an additional protective topcoat sprayed on top as well.

What are the characteristics of Taj Cowhide that should be understood when selecting this product?

Because of the sheen inherent with pearlized/metallic leathers, fat wrinkles and other natural defects are accentuated. The luster actually makes these natural characteristics more apparent in these hides than they would be in a duller or matte finish leather.

t should also be noted that fat wrinkles and other natural markings show more apparently in darker colors







of Taj Cowhide than in lighter Colors colors. starting at deep orange and darker considered are "dark colors" and so there should be an expectation that these colors. especially very dark colors like blue and black, will show more natural characteristics



than lighter colors. When specifying darker colors in Taj, this should be taken into consideration in light of your clients' expectations.

Why is this leather called "Taj" anyway?

The 48 standard colors of our Taj colorway were inspired by the legacy of the Taj Mahal in India. Our pearlized white color represents the structural triumph itself, the white marble mausoleum still standing on the banks of the Jumna River, built by Emperor Shah Jahan in memory of his late wife in the 1600's. Our pearlized black color commemorates the black marble monument the Emperor wished to build for his own burial. The golds, silvers, and jewel-toned colors of this collection honor the artisans who labored to create this architectural masterpiece and decorated the interior with gemstones in their elaborate and intricate design work.



Today, our archives feature hundreds of custom options of Taj Cowhide we've made over the years; and if you don't find the exact Taj color you're looking for in our sample library, a custom color can be developed.
